

## Instructions for the composition – Selection Process

Please find below some instructions for writing your composition for the St. Paul's Foundation Scholarship Programme selection process:

- 1) The text must contain around 200 words and be written by the candidate as an original piece, without the support of artificial intelligence resources.
- 2) The composition must be handwritten in English.
- 3) Choose one of the themes below to develop your composition:
  - a. What do you like most about yourself right now? And why?
  - b. What do you think will be different about the world when you are an adult?
  - c. How would your friends describe you?
- 4) Use dark ink pen, such as black or blue, to write the text.
- 5) When you scan or photograph the text to update it on our website, make sure that the writing is clear and has enough contrast from the paper.
- 6) Sign your name after the next, at the lower part of the page.
- 7) You don't need to use the theme you've chosen as a title for the composition. Just make sure the idea is in the text.
